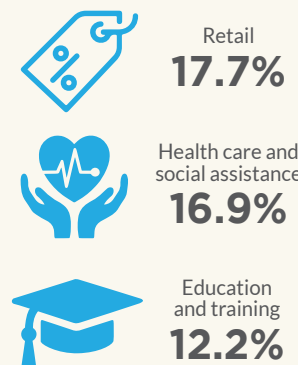

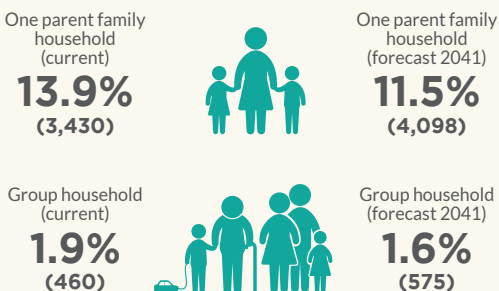

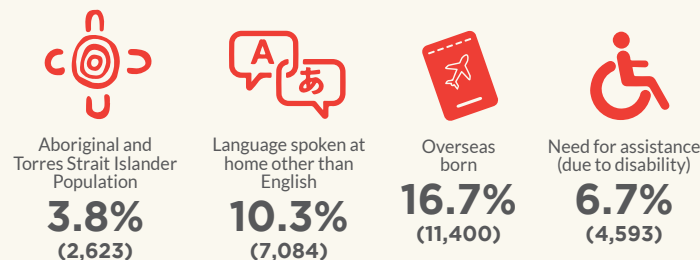
Estimated number of people aged 18 years and over who feel safe walking alone in local area after dark



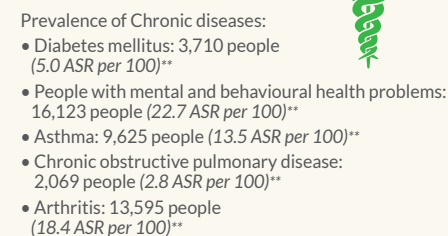

- High or very high distress: 7,857 people (14.6 ASR per 100)**
- High blood pressure: 13,362 people (23.9 ASR per 100)**
- Overweight (not obese): 18,489 people (34.3 ASR per 100)**
- Obese: 20,349 people (37.2 ASR per 100)**
- Current smokers: 9,629 people (18.1 ASR per 100)**
- Consumed more than two alcoholic drinks per day: 9,077 people (16.8 ASR per 100)**
